- Really excited because we received a \$3000 grant for our Donley library. Teachers were also able to purchase and bring to their libraries in their classrooms.

DSC Report: Rhiannon Worgess-Carveth

- Each month different representative attends the meeting. This month Jen Japeck who helps with the K9 for change program came with her dog, Gus. We are hoping to have a dog here but need to find the right placement.
- Fundraising- it was discussed that different schools are being told different things are allowed or not allowed. Dori chatted with equity and inclusion and will be looking to come up with a set of rules for the parent councils.

Committee Reports/Fundraising Opportunities:

- Box Tops: There are a few families signed up at this time. Need to see if we are generating anything.
- Amazon Smile: More and more families are signing up. This is going well.
- **Kroger**: Money brought in each month from families who are signed up.
- **Marco's**: Picked up check for \$64.24. Moving forward the checks will be mailed to us. They are under new management.
- Spirit Wear: still selling online. Got \$300 check from previous sale. Look into a promotion for the holidays.
- **Square 1 Art Project:** Changed system to directly ship to home and that resulted in lower sales. \$1798 in sales. Our profit will be much lower than last year. Will need to look into this for next year to see if we can figure out a way to avoid shipping costs.

Will send sign up genius for help during preview times. Sending home flyers for parents to add to e-wallets. Signs out Monday. Wednesday evening will be open from after school to 6pm.
- Linda McNight fund: Julie emailed and gave direction as to what it could go towards. They are trying to get a sense of what is needed most. Let them know that we can take care of and get things ordered. Told them we can get a sticker or stamp in memory of to put in each book. There is a specific book that her mom loved. We are hoping to get the title so that we can purchase it to keep in the library for students to read in the future. Thinking that the library keeps best care of it so it would be here for years to come. Talked about making a display and taking a picture to send to family.
