 - 3) The board recommends we do not show this video and accompanying materials at the 4th grade level and forgo introducing HIV and AIDS until 5th grade, or we see if Michigan Model to switch the 5th and 4th grade levels regarding the videos and accompanying materials.

- 2. Viewed some of the HIV and AIDS video for 7/8th grades called "Understanding HIV and Aids."
 - 1) Reviewed the video. The groups initial thoughts were mixed/positive.
 - 1) Started a bit corny but ended up being factual and could entertaining from a teen's perspective.
 - 2) Need to finish the last half of the video.
