Please be advised that East Lansing Public Schools in partnership with Madonna University will offer a one (1) credit course entitled "Teaching Across Cultural Differences" this fall. This course has been developed to support staff understanding of cultural competencies that impact our work with a diverse student and family demographic. Registration information is included in this announcement.

## **Course Description:**

This course is designed to allow participants to examine how socially constructed categories (e.g., social class, race, gender, sexual orientation, disability, etc.) are used to privilege some learners and marginalize others. Participants will explore pedagogies and instructional strategies for educating culturally diverse students and engage in critical reflection about what it means to be a teacher of culturally diverse students. Topics will include, but are not limited to, culturally relevant pedagogy, equity pedagogy, and culturally relevant teaching. Specific attention will be given to how race, class, and gender (as cultural identities) impact the teaching and learning process. Central themes of the course include culture, power, and difference. A focus on critical multicultural education as important for classroom learning and curriculum development is also central in this course. Since the course is designed to inform teacher practice, course material will include teacher and student narratives and focus on teaching for social justice as a way to provide equity in education for all students.
