- Fully meets the National Sexuality Education Standards
- Offers a Michigan-adapted version aligned to state law
- Focuses on functional knowledge and healthy behavior skills

The Michigan Standard Aligned version of *Rights, Respect, and Responsibility* has undergone review by a team of district educators, administrators, and parents, and has been recommended to the ELPS Board of Education for consideration. As part of ELPS's curriculum review and adoption process, members of the school community — caregivers, parents, families, educators, staff, and students — are all welcome to review lessons and materials, ask questions, and learn more about the recommendation from the district's Sex Education Advisory Board.
