



## East Lansing High School Football Spectator Information

- Gates will open 1 hour prior to game time
- All tickets are \$7.00 and must be purchased through GoFan <https://gofan.co/app/school/MI14231>. There will not be any cash sales at the gate. We will have a QR code available and credit card readers.
  - Please do not redeem tickets until instructed to do so by ticket staff on site.
  - We encourage you to purchase tickets in advance to avoid delays in entering stadium.
- Spectators may be asked to show ID before entering the gate.
- Only students from East Lansing and the competing school will be allowed to attend the game. Students from the visiting school must show their student ID to be granted entry. If a student from a school that is not competing wants to attend, they must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- No outside food or beverages allowed.
- No re-entry, no pets, no balls, frisbees, etc.
- Limited bag policy: Spectators are not allowed to bring purses larger than a clutch size (6.5x4.5 inches), tote bags, backpacks, diaper bags, camera bags, binocular cases, seatbacks with pockets, and other similar bags into the stadium. Patrons are allowed one large clear Ziploc type storage bag if needed for medical supplies or baby/young children supplies.
- Spectators 8<sup>th</sup> grade and below must be accompanied by, seated with and supervised by an adult throughout the event.
- The following general policies apply to all spectators:
  - Tunnels for players are prohibited.
  - Air horns, whistles, megaphones and speakers are not allowed, nor is body paint.
  - Use of alcohol or tobacco, including e-cigarettes or other smoking devices is prohibited on East Lansing Public Schools property.
  - The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited.
  - Participating teams and spectators are prohibited from streaming live video of any portion of the event over the Internet – including social media platforms such as Periscope and Facebook – or any other method without prior approval.
  - Unless moving to and from restrooms or concessions, students are expected to be in the bleachers.
- Photographers must have MHSAA/media credentials prominently visible to be allowed access to the track or sidelines.
- Sideline/track access is only for coaching staff, players, cheerleaders, school administration and credentialed media.
- At no time are spectators allowed on the track or field.
