What is Student Growth Percentile (SGP)?

Student Growth Percentiles (SGPs) describe a student's learning over time compared to other students with comparable prior test scores.

Student Growth Percentiles (SGPs) help students, parents, and educators determine if a student's learning is above, near, or below the average of their comparison group.











