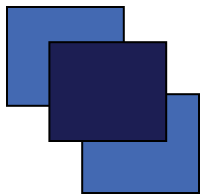

Tutoring and Academic Support

Tutoring and Academic Support is now available in the ELHS media center. The after school program runs M, W, and Th from 2:50 pm to 4:00 pm. This program is staffed with volunteers from Michigan State University, ELHS students, parent volunteers, and the ELHS counselors.

Because every student needs to succeed in completing graduation requirements, academic support is offered to any student who may be struggling in a particular class or who may need a quiet supervised setting for homework. Computers with Internet access and printers are available in the library media center for student use. Students are required to sign in and a quiet atmosphere is

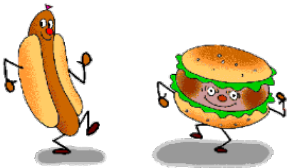


Join the Fun! Jr/Sr Activities sign up is here!

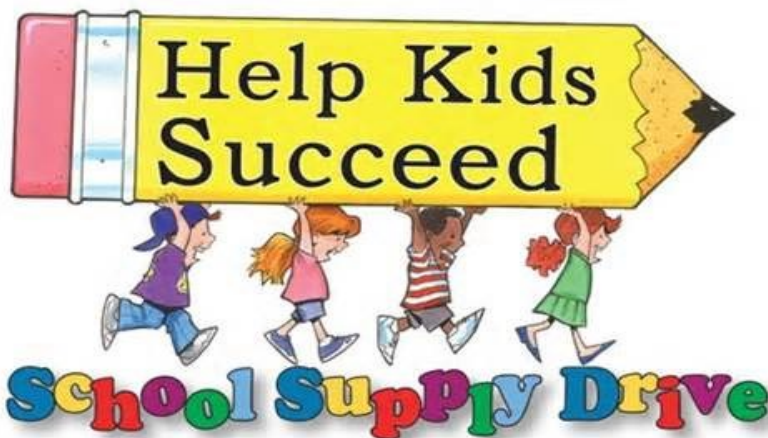
