Final transcripts will NOT be sent out automatically if your student's transcript was previously requested and sent though PARCHMENT. They will need to log on to their Parchment account once again and request a FINAL TRANSCRIPT. Instructions for requesting a transcript through Parchment are available in Student Services.

If your student needs a hard copy of their transcript for any reason there is a \$3 fee that must be paid to ELHS at the time it is requested. Please have your student stop in to see Mrs. Bledsoe to request a hard copy.

Testing Out Procedures

April 14, 2017

East Lansing High School 2017-18 Testing Out Information Test Dates: Tuesday, August 8 & 22, 2017

Students who demonstrate a competency level equivalent to or exceeding the standard of the required courses for graduation may request a test to proceed to the next course.

Testing Out Procedure:

- The application form is due to the East Lansing High School Student Services office no later than May 26, 2017. This form will be available after spring break, and may be found online by going to the East Lansing High School Student Services page on the website, or a printed version will be available in upcoming issues of Trojan Parentline. Hard copies should be mailed to ELHS, 509 Burcham Drive, East Lansing, MI 48823 Attn: Student Services. You may also fax the form to 517-333-7505. All forms must arrive to the school by the due date.
- 2. Testing Out will be conducted two Tuesdays in August in the ELHS Student Union. Two sessions will be offered each day. The morning session will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m., and the afternoon session will begin promptly at 12:30 p.m. Students should enter ELHS through the Night Activities Entrance and report to check-in at least 15 minutes prior to start time. Students will not be allowed to enter the testing site once the testing begins.
- 3. To test out of a required course for graduation, a grade of 78%/C+ or better must be obtained on the test. Passing the test will grant credit toward graduation. Student and parent will be notified by mail in late August or early September (prior to the start of school) of the test(s) result(s). For students obtaining the required grade, schedules will *automatically* be adjusted prior to the first day of school. There is no need to schedule an appointment with a counselor.
- 4. To maintain the security of the tests, they will not be returned to the students. However, the department chair will review the tests and test results with the student and/or parent if requested. <u>A test out may</u> <u>only be attempted once per course.</u>
- 5. Students may attempt to test out of all prerequisite courses.
- 6. Test Out is not available to students who have not yet enrolled in the district.

Course Material Loan:

- 1. Study materials will be checked out to all students Monday Wednesday, June 19-21, in the Student Services office. Check out times are 8-11 am and 1-3 pm.
- 2. A \$70 deposit check must be rendered at the time of the check out for <u>each</u> textbook checked out. Checks will be returned when books are returned on the testing date. Payment must be submitted in the form of a check. Cash and credit cards are not accepted.


