### Principal's Letter

It's hard to believe we're almost halfway through the school year! It seems only a few weeks ago that we welcomed our students back into the building. Now, with the move into second semester fast approaching, students are prepping for final exams and getting ready to start fresh on the 23rd.

#### Drops and Adds – Spring Semester

2<sup>nd</sup> semester drops/adds will occur in Student Services on Wednesday, January 18<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, January 19<sup>th</sup> from school dismissal until 12:30pm. Students can pick up the drop/add form in student services and will need a parent signature to approve any core class change. Many 2<sup>nd</sup> semester classes are full, so the counselors may not be able to accommodate a student's request due to the class numbers.

#### **PSAT Information**

The PSAT scores for the test date that some of our student's elected to take in October are now available. Students may pick up their score reports in student services. Students will also need to make an account at <u>www.</u> <u>collegeboard.org</u>. ELHS also does not have the ability to troubleshoot College Board account issues. Students will need to contact College Board if they need help setting up their account or accessing their scores.

#### Scheduling Information for 2017-2018 School Year

Counselors will be hosting grade level assemblies during excels to hand out registration information. Juniors – Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, Sophomores – Thursday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, and Freshman – Tuesday, January 31<sup>st</sup>

Students will meet with their counselors to request their courses for the 2017-2018 school year. Appointment times will be posted outside of student services starting on January 24<sup>th</sup>. Juniors will schedule February 1,2,3, and 6. Sophomores will schedule February 9,9,10, and 13. Freshman will schedule February 22, 23, 27, and 28.

We will be hosting a Junior Parent Night on Tuesday, January 31<sup>st</sup> at 7pm in the Student Union. At this presentation, we will be going over what junior parents need to expect as their children move towards their senior year in high school. Topics such as graduation, college applications, NCAA clearinghouse, etc will be covered.

We are still working out the details of how scheduling will work for the 8<sup>th</sup> graders. We will share those details in the next issue of Parentline for those of you that may have a current 8<sup>th</sup> grader.

#### Dual Enrollment and Online Grades – Fall Semester

Students are required to turn in grade reports if they took a fall dual enrollment or online class. These grade reports need to be turned in to student services so that the registrar can place them on a student's transcript.

#### Seventh Semester Transcripts

Seventh semester transcripts will be available for students in the graduating class of 2017 at the end of January. Many colleges will request 7th semester transcripts from our students.

Direct to College - Students may request their 7th semester transcripts through parchment.com at any time.

In this course, students learn skills to bolster knowledge in writing and reporting the news, including: interview skills and how to use information from interviews to write news, sports, and feature stories as well as editorials; professional journalistic law and ethics; page design and graphic design; photojournalism; and media literacy.




