Other options include updated video security system to digital, replace and add to inventory of student laptops, replace monitors with flat panel screens, additional document cameras, distance learning devices installed in HUB and library upgrades, including additional search kiosks. The \$4.5 MM tech spending breakdown will be presented at the Monday, November 28 BOE meeting. Questions and answers with the council group. Concern expressed about structure of bond's tech funding. Group suggestion that a parent and H S student be included in the ELPS Tech Committee.
