

EDUCATION: A Civil Right and Privilege That We Must Protect

THE LABOR COUNCIL FOR LATIN AMERICAN ADVANCEMENT GREATER LANSING AREA CHAPTER 2024 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD CRITERIA

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of a public Greater Lansing Area High School (Eastern, Everett, Sexton, East Lansing, Haslett, Okemos, Holt, and Waverly) and have at least a 2.5 grade point average or higher.
- 2. The applicant must be accepted to an accredited 2- or 4-year public/state college or vocational school.
- 3. Applicant must fill out the application completely, accurately, and provide letter of college acceptance to be considered.
- 4. Applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a non-family member.
- 5. Students awarded the scholarship will be notified by email.
- 6. The scholarship recipient(s) and parent(s) or guardian(s) must attend the LCLAA Awards program to be held on Saturday, April 20, 2024, at 12pm at the UAW Local 652, 426 Clare Street, Lansing, MI 48917.
- 7. Scholarships are NON-Renewable and are given on a one-time basis.
- 8. Application and essay must be received no later than 5:00 pm., on Sunday March 24th, 2024.

You will need to provide/upload an unofficial transcript, letter of recommendation and essay with your application. Please upload these in PDF format.
