# Summer EBT is Back!



#### What are SUN Bucks?

SUN Bucks is the new name for Summer EBT. Eligible families of school-age children will receive \$120 per child for qualifying groceries.

# Who Should Apply?

Families that are not automatically enrolled should apply for SUN Bucks directly.

Note: Families will be automatically enrolled in Sun Bucks if they are already enrolled in SNAP, TANF, or FDPIR benefits or meet the requirements for free or reduced-price school meals. In other words, keep an eye out for \$120 per child at the beginning of summer!

Deadlines: Apply by April 15, 2025, to be eligible for the first issuance of benefits in May. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until August 31, 2025.
