FEBRUARY SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: February 19, 2026 & March 31, 2026

1) Gordon A. Rich Memorial Scholarship - \$60,000 - 9 Awards (Deadline: February 19, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior.
- B) Have a minimum grade point average of 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale) and rank in the top 20% of your class.

2) STEM Stars Actuarial Scholars Program - \$20,000 - 15 Awards (Deadline: February 27, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Demonstrate proficiency in mathematics, including Algebra or Calculus.
- B) Express a sincere intent to pursue a career in the actuarial field.

3) Scholarships360 Scholarship - \$10,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: February 28, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior, current undergraduate or graduate student.
- B) Be enrolled in a US-accredited institution on a full-time basis for the Fall 2026 semester.

4) Horatio Alger Scholarship - \$15,000 - 70 Awards (Deadline: March 1, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled full-time as a high school junior in the United States.
- B) Demonstrate critical financial need (\$65,000 or lower adjusted gross family income is required).

5) WWGF Foundation Scholarships - \$20,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: March 7, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be an active participant in the sport of golf (golf ability is not a criterion for selection).
- B) Have a 3.5 GPA or above on a 4.0 scale.

6) Nabi Nicole Grant Memorial Scholarship - \$5,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: March 8, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be from an underrepresented minority.
- B) Demonstrate financial need.

7) Navy Supply Corps Foundation Scholarship - \$20,000 - 28 Awards (Deadline: March 13, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a child or grandchild of a living or deceased regular, retired, reserve Navy Supply Corps officer.
- B) Maintain a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.

8) American Society of Mechanical Engineers Scholarship - \$5,000 – 4 Awards (Deadline: Mar 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior interested in pursuing an engineering degree.
- B) Be enrolled full-time in a mechanical engineering or mechanical engineering technology program, no later than the fall after their senior year in high school.

9) Kailee Mills Foundation Scholarship Program - \$20,000 - 16 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have volunteered for organizations in their community and submit verifiable proof of volunteer hours.
- B) Have a current GPA of 3.2 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

10) Journalist of the Year Scholarships - \$4,000 – 6 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Plan to study journalism and/or mass communications in college and pursue a career in that field.
- B) Be a graduating high school senior (or equivalent) planning to attend college.

11) UCT Charities Heaston Scholarship - \$24,000 – 3 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled and entering a college program in the coming academic year.
- B) Demonstrate academic success and extracurricular success in high school.

12) National Restaurant Association Scholarships - \$10,000 - 150 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be pursuing a post-secondary degree in the restaurant, foodservice, or hospitality industry.
- B) Be enrolled in a US-accredited institution on a full-time basis for the Fall 2026 semester.

13) Pogorzelski-Yankee Memorial Scholarships - \$15,000 - 2 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled as full-time student in a nationally or regionally accredited undergraduate institution (colleges, universities, or conservatories) during the 2026–27 academic year.
- B) Be willing to showcase their talent on the organ through three video-recorded performances.

14) Women Marines Association Scholarship Program - \$5,000 - 9 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a direct descendant by blood, legal adoption, or stepchild of a Marine on active duty or who has served honorably in the United States Marine Corps, Regular or Reserve.

15) SparkForce Scholarships- \$3,500 - 3 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled in or planning to enroll in a manufacturing-related program.
- B) Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) for community, trade, or technical college students, or 3.0 for university students.
