Test out dates will be Wednesday, August 14th and Tuesday, August 20th 2024. Students may take up to two tests per date. The PE test-out requires two sessions.

Study materials will be available to pick up from the school by parents or guardians on Monday, June 3rd - Wednesday June 5th, 2024 between the hours of 8:00am - 11:00am.

As a reminder, if your student decides to attempt to test out of a class, they must score a 78% or higher to receive credit for that class.



ELHS Application for Summer Credit Recovery

East Lansing High School will be offering credit recovery June 12 – July 16 (no class the week of July 3). The first two weeks will be in person with the final two weeks being virtual. This session will be supervised by a certified ELHS teacher. The curriculum is Edgunity, an online credit recovery system. Only courses previously failed may be recovered.

- There is no cost for students to take summer credit recovery this year.
- Students must attend the in person session days unless an exception has been made for an extenuating circumstance and approved by the teacher.
- In Person class time is 10 am 12 pm Monday Thursday. A second afternoon session from 1pm 3pm may be added based on demand.
- · Classes must be completed (final taken) by the end of the session.
- The deadline to complete this form to request credit recovery is Wednesday, June 7th, 2022. Acceptance will be based on student need and space availability.
- Successfully completed courses will appear on your transcript with a passing grade ('S') and the failing grade ('E') will be removed from your GPA calculation, but will remain on your transcript.
- Student Athletes: E2020 courses are not accepted by the NCAA Eligibility Center.






