Tom Schneider Peacemaker Award

The Peace Education Center (PEC) is honored to annually present the Tom Schneider Peacemaker Award to graduating high school seniors who have **demonstrated** a commitment to peace and social justice through advocacy and leadership. Seniors from Ingham, Eaton, and Clinton counties and Laingsburg are eligible.

The award honors the memory of Tom Schneider, who served on the board of the Peace Education Center, and tirelessly worked for social justice and peace in our community, and in our world.

We believe that young people who work for justice and peace should be honored for their contributions toward creating a better community for all of us.

Students can apply or be nominated for this award. To be considered for the Tom Schneider Peacemaker Award, students must meet the following criteria:

- → Graduate from a high school program in the mid-Michigan area in the spring of 2025.
- → Describe how the nominee has led and/or advocated for social justice and peace issues – at school, in the community and beyond – and outline their plans to continue their active efforts toward peace and justice in their future endeavors.

A PEC committee, including Tom Schneider's wife Becky Schwarz, will select the Peacemaker(s) in April, with a framed certificate and minimum award of \$500.

Submit your application or nomination, along with two letters of reference, no later than **April 1, 2025.**


