## **End of School Year Activities**

The last few weeks of school can be quite busy with celebrations and events both in and out of school. Some of these, but not all, require volunteers. Here is a rundown of what year end activities are currently planned so you can get those dates that apply to your family on your calendar now. Not all events will apply to all families as many are grade/ activity specific. More information will be provided closer to the event dates.

**Track and Field Days** – 5<sup>th</sup> grade May 30<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> grade May 31<sup>st</sup>, rain date June 1<sup>st</sup>: These events happen during the school day and require a few volunteers to act as timers and field event helpers. 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students from all elementary schools are bussed to the middle school to compete in fun sporting events.

**Jump Rope Show** - June 1<sup>st</sup> from 2:30-3:30pm: Parents of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> graders on the Jump Rope Team come and enjoy their jumpers' performance!

**Glencairn Field Day** - June 5<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon: This outdoor school wide event includes games such as soccer, water balloon tosses, relay races, and volleyball and is a favorite of all ages. Parent volunteers will be needed in the afternoon.

**Hoop Troupe Show** - June 6<sup>th</sup>: The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students in Hoop Troupe will perform for students during the school day and in the evening for parents. Just come and enjoy the show!

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade Field Trip** - June 7<sup>th</sup>: The 4<sup>th</sup> graders will be visiting Frederik Meijer Gardens and Hoffmaster State Park. 4<sup>th</sup> grade parent chaperones may be welcome-check with the 4<sup>th</sup> grade teachers.

**All School 5K** - June 8<sup>th</sup>: We will celebrate our mileage club grant with a 5K in the afternoon mostly on school grounds. A few volunteers would be helpful.

**Year End Picnic** - This will likely be in the evening on June 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup>: Hot dogs will be provided by the PTO. Bring a side dish to pass and come enjoy the music! Volunteers to help with set up, clean up, and serving would be helpful.

**Water Day and Aquatic Center Field Trip** - June 13<sup>th</sup> during the school day: K and 1<sup>st</sup> grade will have fun water activities at school. A parent coordinator and volunteers will help make this day a success. 2<sup>nd</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup> grade will go to the East Lansing Aquatic Center. Parent chaperones will be welcome but will need to provide their own transportation.

**5<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation Breakfast** - June 15<sup>th</sup> in the morning: Parents will not want to miss their 5th graders in their graduation caps.

**Packing Parties** - As we prepare for our temporary move to Red Cedar the staff may need help with packing up the building. Volunteers to help pack up parts of the school would be a wonderful way to assist our staff! Dates will likely be the last week of school and the week after school ends and may include weekends and/or evenings.

There are lots of things going on at the end of the year (classroom, school wide, special performances) and we really appreciate how much parents contribute and how much they volunteer their time. We recognize that not everyone can help and that's ok.
