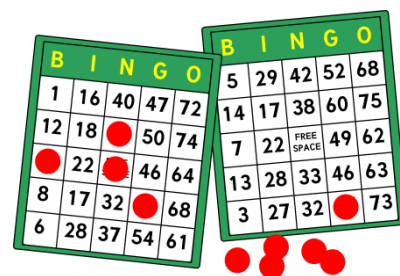

Fundraiser Reminders

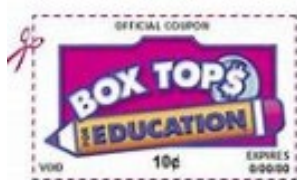
Don't forget about these easy, year-long ways to earn funds for our school:
