Over the past several months, the Michigan Department of Education has been working with the Center for Educational Performance and Information (CEPI) to advance the State Board of Education's vision of an easy-to-use online dashboard filled with meaningful school-level data for families. The resulting PARENT DASHBOARD for School Transparency was developed with extensive input from parents and educators. It includes 20 school-level metrics parents and others say are important to them. The official launch for the new Parent Dashboard will occur on January 9, 2018.

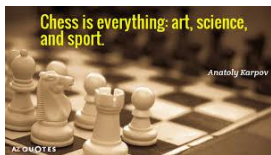


MRS. FLOYD'S BUCHE DE NOEL COMPETITION

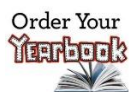
