<u>Please Note:</u> All fees for the 2018 Girls Basketball Season Will Be Collected at the Parent Orientation Meeting on Wed. January 10th.

Games: 10 Game schedule starting Jan. 22. Games are typically twice per week on Monday and Wednesday's starting at 4:30pm.

*Participants of middle school sports must have a physical on file before the first day of practice. Your Doctor must complete physical information on the MHSAA Medical History form which is available at the East Lansing Hannah Community Center or in the MacDonald Middle School main office.

*Academic eligibility: In order to attend tryouts, potential players must register in the school office between Dec. 11th and no later than Dec. 15th. A student athlete must have no "E's" in any classes to be eligible to tryout. During the season, in order to participate a student must have no "E's" in any classes.



Western Michigan District Junior Team Tennis Winter 2018

Who: 18 & Under, 14 & Under, 12 & Under & 10 & Under - Green Ball

What: Junior Team Tennis - a great chance to play team matches with your friends (or make new ones!)

When: Winter Indoor: January 5 - March 18

Why: To play competitive matches with friends with a chance to go to the playoffs. It is a great addition to regular lessons and programs as you are playing other players from outside your home town or club.

Cost: Just \$10 league fee. You do not have to be a USTA Member although it is suggested. Match fees are determined by the number of players on your team at each match.

For a 2 hour match

Number of Players at your match	Match Fee per player
3	\$16
4	\$12
5	\$10
6	\$8

Format: Matches consist of a minimum of 3 players per team (any mix of genders allowed). Matches are played on 2 courts. The matches are 6 game sets with no ad scoring or a 30 minute time limit, whichever happens first. One court will have singles all 4 time slots and one court will be doubles.

Example of a 2 hour match:

Court 1		Court 2
12:00	#1 Singles	Doubles
12:30	#2 Singles	Doubles
1:00	#3 Singles	Doubles
1:30	#4 Singles	Doubles

If only 3 players are at a match, the #4 Singles is played by any one of the 3 players. Captains should try to match up levels with the #4 Singles player from the other team (we don't want to put the #1 player against the #4 player if the levels are not appropriate). If you have 4 or more players, no player can play more than one singles match.

Teams: Consist of at least 4 players with 6-8 players suggested per team. Individual matches can have anywhere from 3-6 players.

To Register:

Players may sign up for a team on TennisLink once their Captain has given them a team number. Please note that the registration process has changed on TennisLink and now all parents of players 13 & Under must create a TennisLink account before registering their player: <u>Player Registration</u>
