Attendance

We don't want your child to fall behind in school and get discouraged. Please ensure that your child attends school every day and arrives on time. The first bell rings at 7:55 a.m. and students are expected to be in the classroom ready to learn by the 8:05 a.m. bell. Here are a few practical tips to help support regular attendance:

- Make sure your child keeps a regular morning routine.
- Ensure your child goes to school every day unless they are truly sick. Students need to be fever free and no vomiting for 24 hours before returning to school.
- Avoid scheduling vacations or doctor's appointments when school is in session. We understand
 that it is difficult to schedule doctor, dentist or orthodontist appointments outside of school hours
 but we ask to please try your best. Beginning November 1, all absences will be left unexcused
 unless a note is provided from the appointment.
- Develop back up plans for getting to/from school if something comes up.
- If your child is feeling anxious about school, please contact his/her counselor.
