MATHCOUNTS° MMS MATHCOUNTS CLUB

The MathCounts club is meeting regularly on Mondays from 3:00 -4:00 p.m. in room 134. Any students interested in stretching their mathematical problem solving muscles are welcome to join us at any time. Thanks to funding from the MMS Parent Council, we have registered the maximum of ten students to participate in the regional MathCounts competition. As a first step in selecting the students who will represent MMS at the local competition in February, we will hold the school competition on Monday, November 6 and 13. This time frame will allow us to take the Sprint round (40 minutes) on the first week, with time to go over it, and the Target round (about 30 minutes) with time to go over it, so that everyone will have a chance to learn, whether they are interested in the competition or not. Based on the results of that competition, we will select a group of about 12 students who will be invited to make a commitment to prepare for the local competition. This commitment will involve spending some time outside of math club solving problems, so that we can use the MathCounts meeting time to go over those problems. Based on students' preparation, attitude, commitment, and progress over the coming weeks, the team of four, and additional individual competitors will be selected early in 2018, closer to the date of the competition.

If students want to be considered for the regional competition, they MUST participate in the school competition on **November 6 AND 13**. If you have an unavoidable conflict, you must let us know IN ADVANCE—either the prior Friday, in case of a scheduled commitment, or Monday before Math Club in the event of a sickness or injury which causes a school absence. We will work to schedule an alternative test date as soon as possible.
