Principal’s Report and Presentation

- Data through the end of January. Overall some significant improvements to celebrate.
- Referrals lower last year than this year. Various reasons for this: new principal, Mrs Scott writes everything up, every referral of discipline to her office; PBIS committee to determine, “what do we document?”
- The district has extended two lunch hour aides through afternoon recess. Ms Monica and Ms Tia will be staying to work with individual or small groups between lunch and afternoon recess, then be on the playground for afternoon recess, in addition to assigned staff.
- Matt Phillips will do training on culturally responsive PBIS beginning next week.
- AIMSweb is a screener, baseline. RCBM (oral reading fluency), Math (QDM quantity discrimination). The kids are improving across the grade levels. See Sarah Scott for detailed report.
- MSTEP will start after Spring Break. Testing time has been reduced. 3-5th graders take the test. The kids will take it online, using the laptops on the carts with their classroom teacher as proctor.
