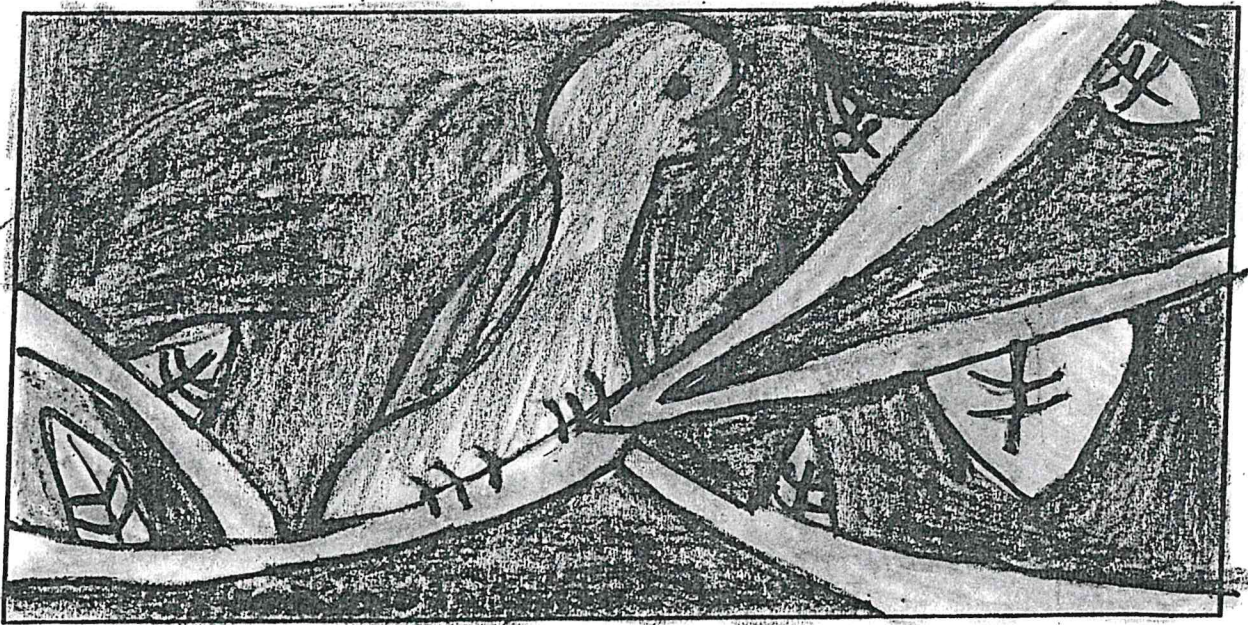

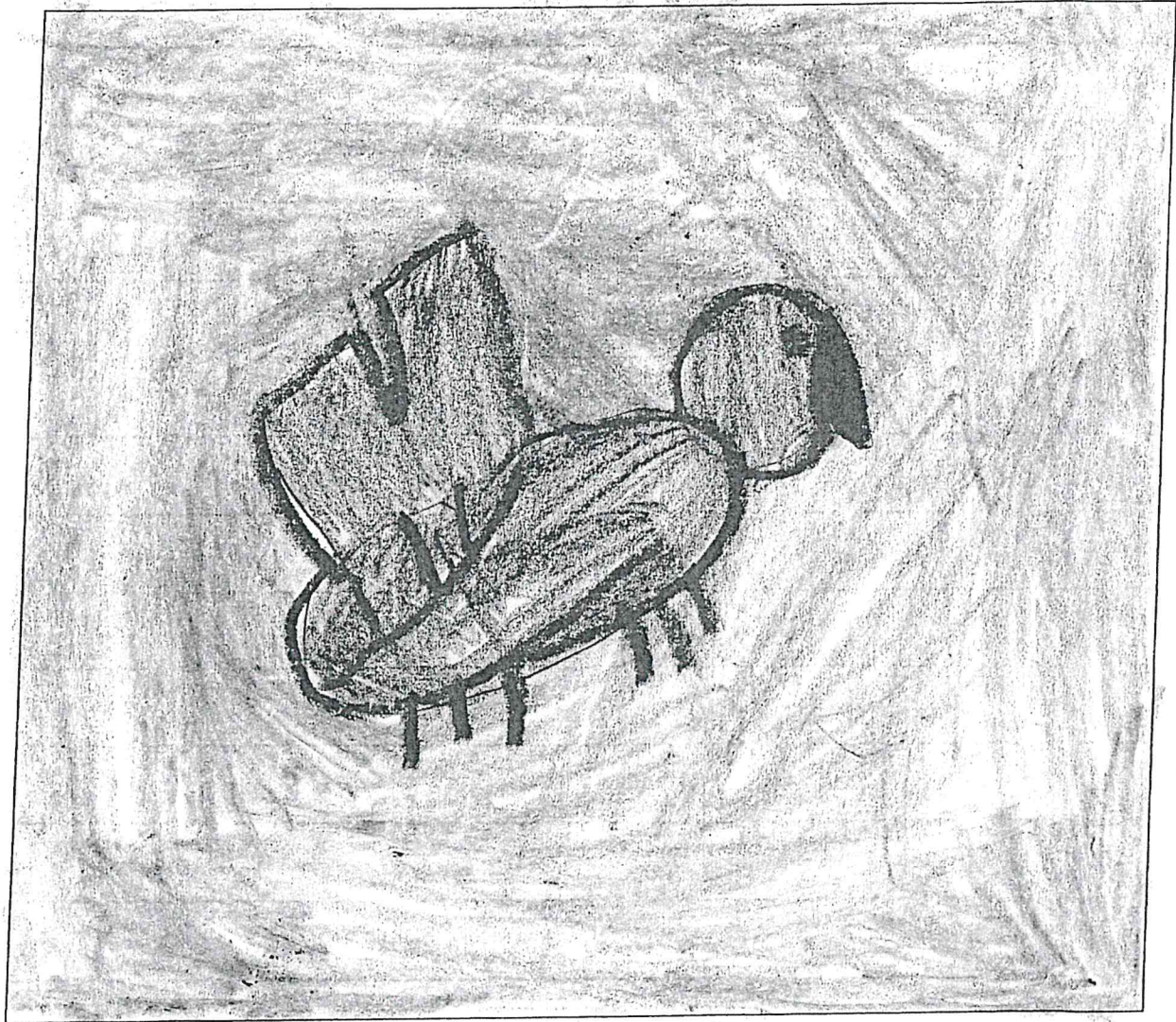

Habitat



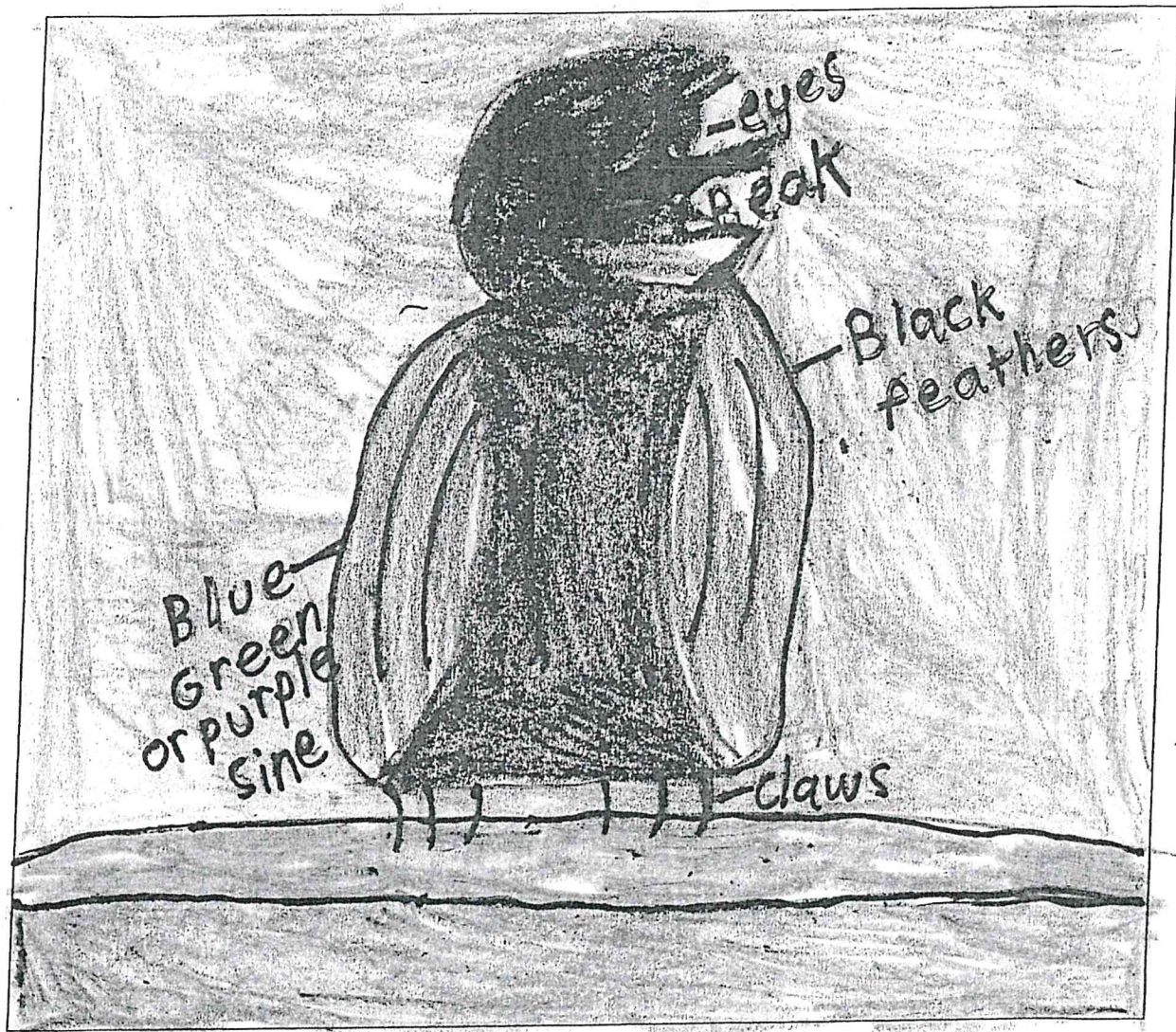
Raven live in trees and branches.
