Responsibilities: Scholarship, Leadership, Character, and Service

- Academics/ Scholarship: A member must maintain a cumulative 3.500 GPA. A member whose cumulative GPA drops below a 3.500 will be warned at the end of that semester. The member must attain a 3.500 GPA for the subsequent semester and reestablish his 3.500 cumulative GPA at the conclusion of the next semester.
- **Leadership**: A member is expected to generate ideas, work towards the execution of ideas, positively influence peers and members of the community and assume responsibilities for tasks large and small.
- Character: A member meets responsibilities, demonstrates high standards of honesty, reliability, fairness
 and tolerance; a member cooperates in a willing spirit with rules and regulations, upholding principles of
 morality and ethics.
- **Service**: A member provides service to others without expecting recognition or reward. Members are required to perform and report at least 25 service hours by the final meeting of each school year. Members must properly report all volunteer hours using the identified NHS platform form. Please plan to have the adult supervisor's signature and phone number in case there is a need to check on hours. Members are STRONGLY encouraged to go above and beyond this basic requirement.
- **Induction**: All new members are required to attend the Induction Ceremony on April 30, 2019 at 6:30pm.

Grounds for Dismissal

- Failure to meet all GPA requirements as stated above may result in dismissal.
- Failure to meet hour requirements, pay dues, or meet attendance requirements may result in dismissal.
- Violation of criminal law or school regulation will result in a dismissal hearing. These violations include, but
 are not limited to, possessing, selling or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, cheating and
 plagiarism, stealing, destroying property and truancy. These rules are binding on and off school property
